DANGER ISLAND HEADQUARTERS -- This is the camp set up for 32 American scientists by the U.S. Navy on Puka Puka, or Danger Island, in the uncharted South Seas, scene of the third installment of "High Adventure with Lowell Thomas" (in color, CBS-TV, Monday, January 19th, 10:00-11:00 p.m., EST). One of the most important projects of the International Geophysical Year, scientists used jet-age instruments, including rockets launched 150 miles into outer space, to record activities of the sun during the October 12th eclipse. Navy frogmen were forced to blast a channel through dangerous reef to land supplies on the seldom-visited island.
